TOPIC: **THE KINGDOM LIFE**

TEXT: Psalm 89:34

Brethren, we live in this world as Kingdom representatives. The bible says in 2 Corinthians 5:20: “Now **then we are ambassadors for Christ** ...”. In other words, we are Kingdom representatives (Halleluyah!). Also, it is important to know that we are not of this world. 1 Peter 2:11 declares: “Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims ...”. Again in Psalm 119:19, the psalmist declares: “I am a stranger in the earth ...”. Therefore, since our citizenship is not of this world, how come we live like those who are of this world? How come about that sickness (Jeremiah 8:22)? How come about that infirmity (Isaiah 55:4, 5)? How come about that bondage (John 8:32)? How come about that bitterness (John 13:35)? How come about that frustration (Philippians 4:4)? How come about that addiction? How come about that lack (Psalm 37:25)? How come about that poverty (Matthew 6:33)? How come about that failure (Psalm 37:4)? All of those are not a part of “The Kingdom Life” (Proverbs 10:22).

1 Peter 2:9 reveals our citizenship: “But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light”. Isn't that awesome? You, a chosen generation; you, a royal priesthood; you, an holy nation; you, a peculiar people; O my God! If only you recognize the power behind whom you are and the Kingdom you represent, you will always live the standard of God.

While those not of this Kingdom live in frustration, depression, sickness, lack, sin, wickedness, darkness, and much more, those who understand and live The Kingdom Life live in completeness for we are complete in Him (Colossians 2:10). Therefore, the Life of the Kingdom is about arising and shining (Isaiah 61:1, 2)! When men say there is casting down, you that are in the Kingdom will say there is lifting up (Job 22:29) because that is the Life of the Kingdom!

Once this deep truth sinks in your inner man, you will begin to dominate everywhere you go because you have the rank of dominion placed on your shoulders. The dominion can only be utilized when you understand the Kingdom you represent here on earth.

The life of the Kingdom we represent is a life of **covenants**. Interestingly, the God of the Kingdom is a covenant keeping God. He gives us so many covenants that He has vowed to keep. Psalm 89:34 declares: My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. We are assured again in Hebrews 6:18: “that by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie”. Numbers 23:19 declares: “God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good”. That is the confidence we have in living The Kingdom Life.

The covenants are so numerous but life changing. The moment these covenants are stored in your spirit man, The Kingdom Life becomes a part of you and it “**intoxicates**” you –





you will **never** want anything short of it. The covenants are: covenant of **NEWNESS OF LIFE**, covenant of **DIVINE HEALTH**, covenant of **LIBERTY**, covenant of **DIVINE PROTECTION**, covenant of **VICTORY**, covenant of **LOVE**, covenant of **PROSPERITY**, covenant of **WISDOM**, covenant of **DOMINION**, covenant of **EXCELLENCE**, covenant of **THE ANOINTING**, covenant of **JUDGEMENT** and much more.

Covenant of NEWNESS OF LIFE:

- Isaiah 43:18, 19 – Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. (19) **Behold, I will do a new thing**; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.
- Isaiah 41:18 – I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and **the dry land springs of water**.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 – Therefore if any man be in Christ, **he is a new creature**: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Romans 6:1, 2, 3, 4 – What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? (2) God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? (3) Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? (4) Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was **raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life**.
- Romans 8:6, 10 – For to be carnally minded is death; but **to be spiritually minded is life** and peace. (10) **And if Christ be in you**, the body is dead because of sin; but **the Spirit is life** because of righteousness.
- 1 John 3:9 – Whosoever is born of God **doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin**, because he is born of God.
- John 4:14 – But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a **well of water springing up into everlasting life**.
- Revelation 21:6 – And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the **fountain of the water of life freely**.

Covenant of DIVINE HEALTH:

- Psalm 105:37 – He brought them forth also with silver and gold: **and there was not one feeble person among their tribes**.
- Jeremiah 8:22 – **Is there no balm in Gilead; is there no physician there? why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?**
- Isaiah 53:4, 5 – **Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows**: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. (5) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; **and with his stripes we are healed**.
- Psalm 107:20 – **He sent his word, and healed them**, and delivered them from their destructions.





- Psalm 103:1-3 – **Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.** (2) Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: (3) Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; **who healeth all thy diseases.**
- Galatians 6:17 – From henceforth let no man (sickness) trouble me: **for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus.**
- Isaiah 59:19 – So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. **When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.**
- Exodus 15:26 – And said, **If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God,** and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, **I will put none of these diseases upon thee,** which I have brought upon the Egyptians: **for I am the Lord that healeth thee.**
- Exodus 23:25 – **And ye shall serve the Lord your God,** and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; **and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.**
- Jeremiah 30:17 – **For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the Lord;** because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after.
- 3 John verse 2 – **Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health,** even as thy soul prospereth.
- Jeremiah 17:14 – **Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed;** save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.
- Proverbs 3:7, 8 – Be not wise in thine own eyes: **fear the Lord, and depart from evil.** (8) **It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.**
- Proverbs 4:20-22 – My son, **attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.** (21) **Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.** (22) **For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.**
- Psalm 42:11 – Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: **for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God.**

Covenant of LIBERTY:

- Psalm 126:1 – **When the Lord turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.**
- Romans 8:1, 2 – **There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus,** who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. (2) **For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.**
- 1 John 3:8 – He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.**
- Colossians 2:14, 15 – **Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to**





- his cross; (15) and having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.**
- Romans 8:12 – Therefore, brethren, **we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.**
 - Matthew 11:12 – And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, **and the violent take it by force.**
 - 2 Corinthians 3:17 – Now the Lord is that Spirit: and **where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.**
 - Galatians 5:1 – **Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free,** and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
 - John 8:32, 36 – **And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. (36) If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.**
 - Hosea 4:6 – **My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge:** because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

Covenant of DIVINE PROTECTION:

- Psalm 91:1-16 – **He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (2) I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. (3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. (4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. (5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; (6) Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. (7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. (8) Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. (9) Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; (10) There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. (11) For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. (12) They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. (13) Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet. (14) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. (15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. (16) With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.**
- Psalm 121:1-8 – I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. (2) My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth. (3) **He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber. (4) Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. (5) The Lord is thy keeper: the Lord is thy shade upon thy right hand. (6) The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night. (7) The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. (8) The Lord shall**





- preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.
- Psalm 125:1-3 – **They that trust in the Lord shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abideth for ever. (2) As the mountains are round about Jerusalem, so the Lord is round about his people from henceforth even for ever. (3) For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous; lest the righteous put forth their hands unto iniquity.**
 - Hebrews 12:22 – **But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels.**
 - 1 John 4:4 – **Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.**
 - Numbers 23:23 – **Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel: according to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, What hath God wrought!**
 - Isaiah 54:14, 15, 17. – **In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee. (15) Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake. (17) No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.**

Covenant of VICTORY:

- 2 Corinthians 2:14 – **Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.**
- 1 John 5:4 – **For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.**
- Revelation 12:11 – **And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.**
- Romans 8:31, 37 – **What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.**

Covenant of LOVE:

- John 13:34, 35 – **A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. (35) By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.**
- John 15:12 – **This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.**
- Romans 12:10, 13, 14 – **Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; (13) distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. (14) Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.**





- Romans 13:8-10 – Owe no man any thing, **but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.** 9 For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; **and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.** 10 Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.
- 1 John 3:10 – **In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.**
- 1 John 4:7, 8, 11, 12 – **Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. (8) He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. (11) Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. (12) No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.**
- 1 Corinthians 13:4-8, 13 – **Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, (5) doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; (6) rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; (7) beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. (8) Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. (13) And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.**
- Romans 8:35, 36, 38, 39 – **Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? (36) As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. (38) For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, (39) nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.**
- Galatians 5:13 – For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, **but by love serve one another.**
- Ephesians 4:2 – With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, **forbearing one another in love;**
- 1 Thessalonians 3:12 – And the Lord make you to **increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men,** even as we do toward you:
- Galatians 6:10 – As we have therefore opportunity, **let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.**
- Hebrews 13:1-3 – **Let brotherly love continue. (2) Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. (3) Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body.**
- 1 Thessalonians 4:9 – **But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.**





- Hebrews 10:24 – And **let us consider one another to provoke unto love** and to good works:
- 1 Peter 1:22 – Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, **see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:**
- 1 Peter 3:8 – Finally, **be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous.**
- 1 John 3:11, 23 – For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, **that we should love one another.** (23) And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, **and love one another,** as he gave us commandment.
- 2 John 1:5, 6 – And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, **that we love one another.** (6) And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.
- Colossians 3:12-14 – Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; (13) **forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.** (14) **And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.**

Covenant of PROSPERITY:

- Deuteronomy 28:10 – **And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the Lord; and they shall be afraid of thee.**
- Deuteronomy 1:11 – **(The Lord God of your fathers make you a thousand times so many more as ye are, and bless you, as he hath promised you!)**
- Deuteronomy 8:18 – **But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth,** that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.
- Isaiah 48:18 – Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; **I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.**
- Psalm 35:27 – Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, **Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.**
- Psalm 24:1 – **The earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.**
- Matthew 6:33 – **But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.**
- Luke 6:38 – **Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.**





- Malachi 3:10-12 – **Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. (11) And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts. (12) And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the Lord of hosts.**
- Isaiah 60:15 – **Whereas thou hast been forsaken and hated, so that no man went through thee, I will make thee an eternal excellency, a joy of many generations.**
- Deuteronomy 15:6 – **For the Lord thy God blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and thou shalt reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over thee.**
- Deuteronomy 28:12 – **The Lord shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.**
- Psalm 34:10 – **The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing.**
- Psalm 37:4, 25 – **Delight thyself also in the Lord; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. (25) I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.**
- Isaiah 58:14 – **Then shalt thou delight thyself in the Lord; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it.**
- Psalm 1:1-3 – **Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. (2) But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. (3) And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.**
- Proverbs 16:3 – **Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established.**
- Psalm 126:5, 6 – **They that sow in tears shall reap in joy. (6) He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.**

Covenant of WISDOM:

- Proverbs 1:7 – **The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.**
- Proverbs 9:10 – **The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.**
- James 3:17 – **But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.**





- Daniel 1:20 – **And in all matters of wisdom and understanding, that the king enquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm.**

Covenant of DOMINION:

- Genesis 1:28 – And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and **have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.
- Luke 10:19 – Behold, **I give unto you power** to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 – Verily I say unto you, **Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**

Covenant of EXCELLENCE:

- Daniel 6:3 – Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, **because an excellent spirit was in him**; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.
- Daniel 5:12 – **Forasmuch as an excellent spirit**, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and shewing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, **were found in the same Daniel**, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will shew the interpretation.

Covenant of THE ANOINTING:

- John 14:12 – Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and **greater works than these shall he do**; because I go unto my Father.
- Mark 16:17, 18 – And **these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; (18) they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.**
- Isaiah 61:1 – **The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me** to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound.
- Luke 4:18, 19 – **The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me** to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (19) to preach the acceptable year of the Lord.
- Romans 8:11, 26 – **But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you**, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. (26) **Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities**: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought:





but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

- 1 Corinthians 4:20 – **For the kingdom of God is not in word, but in power.**
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 – And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, **but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:**
- 1 Corinthians 12:7 – **But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.**
- Isaiah 10:27 – **And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.**
- Joel 2:28 – **And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh;** and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

Covenant of JUDGEMENT:

- Hebrews 9:27 – And as **it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:**
- Romans 2:16 – **In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.**
- Hebrews 12:28, 29 – Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, **let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: (29) for our God is a consuming fire.**
- Ezekiel 18:4 – Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: **the soul that sinneth, it shall die.**
- Romans 6:23 – **For the wages of sin is death;** but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Hebrews 10:38, 39 – Now the just shall live by faith: **but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. (39) But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition;** but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.
- Proverbs 14:12 – **There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.**
- Malachi 4:1 – For, behold, **the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the Lord of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.**
- Deuteronomy 8:19 – And it shall be, **if thou do at all forget the Lord thy God,** and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, **I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish.**
- Proverbs 29:1 – **He, that being often reproveth hardeneth his neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.**

Other life changing covenants include: **covenant of JOY** – Psalm 16:11; **covenant of PEACE** – Isaiah 26:3, John 14:27; **covenant of LONG LIFE** – Psalm 91:16; **covenant of GOOD SLEEP** – Psalm 127:2; **covenant of DIVINE FAVOUR** – Proverbs 16:7, Proverbs 21:1; **covenant of DIVINE**





DIRECTION Psalm 32:8; **covenant of FRUITFULNESS** – Exodus 23:26, Genesis 1:28, Psalm 127:3; **covenant of DIVINE REVELATION** – 1 John 2:20, 1 Corinthians 1:5, Jeremiah 33:3, Deuteronomy 29:29; **covenant of ANSWERS TO PRAYER** – Matthew 21:22, Matthew 7:7-11.

The numerous blessings that avail to you and I in this Kingdom are inexhaustible. It's only as you dwell in the Kingdom, that the Lord reveals more and more to you each day (by His Word and blessed Holy Spirit). There is no end to the wealth of blessings this Kingdom has to offer. Isaiah 9:6, 7 declares: "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. (7) **Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end**, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this". The increase of His Government or Kingdom has no end! This Kingdom was brought to earth and restored when Christ came to earth. The most important thing about this Kingdom is that the Kingdom has everything you need. So, make sure to be a partaker of this Kingdom!

The only way to be a part of this Kingdom is Jesus. John 14:6 declares: "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me". You've got to be born again. If that is your desire, say this prayer with total sincerity and the Lord will hear you:

Lord Jesus, I believe you are the son of God, I believe you came to earth 2000 years ago, I believe you died on a cross for me, I believe you rose again on the 3rd day, and I believe you are coming back again. Lord Jesus, come in to my heart. Wash me, make me clean. Purge my life with your precious blood and make me new. Thank you for accepting me into your Kingdom. Give me the grace to live the standard of God, the Kingdom Life.

Now that you are saved, you've got to hold on to your salvation unto the end:

1. Get yourself a bible and meditate on it daily so God can speak to you and reveal more of the Kingdom to you.
2. Be prayerful as that is the only way we can speak to God.
3. Join a bible believing (Spirit-filled) church so you can be among the brethren and grow spiritually.

It's that simple. That's the beginning of joy unspeakable which has no end. God bless you!
