In the last 2 editions of the ministry newsletter, the Lord revealed to us that every problem has an expiry date. This time around, we will see how the Lord moves us from a great mess into greatness after the expiration of all calamities.

In Isaiah 60:15, the word declares: “Whereas thou hast been forsaken and hated, so that no man went through thee, **I will** make thee an eternal excellency, a joy of many generations”. We see here that it is God who will take us into greatness; for the scripture says “I will” referring to God Almighty. Too many people run to mere mortals for strength, power, riches, fame, and everything you can think of. Some even run to the devil. How sad!

The scripture says in Psalm 20:7, “Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the Lord our God”. Remembering the name of the Lord is the key to greatness. It’s that simple. For the name of the Lord is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe (Proverbs 18:10). Remembering the name of the Lord means being faithful (Deuteronomy 28:1); it could also mean getting up at night to pray and knock until the door is open (Isaiah 62:6, 7); it also means simple obedience to the word of the Lord (1 Samuel 15:23); it means believe (2 chronicles 20:20); and it means holding on in unclear situations (James 1:2-4).

Sometimes, the road or journey may seem clouded but always hold on to the name of the Lord. That is the key to greatness. The psalmist said in Psalm 37:25: “I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread”. In other words, I have been young and now am old, yet I have not seen those who remember the name of the Lord put to shame or disappointed! He never fails. He always takes those who trust His name to greatness. Romans 10:13 declares: “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved”. There’s something about that name. It moves people to greatness (Hallelujah). No matter whom you are and where you are coming from or what you are going through, remember the name, the name of JESUS! It’s a name higher than every name (Philippians 2:9-11). It’s the name that moves to greatness – the name of JESUS!

- Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the Lord JEHOVAH is everlasting strength (Isaiah 26:4).
