Pre-Trip:

Wow! What a tremendous privilege it is to serve our wonderful Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! The Philippines crusade and ministry outreach was a very unforgettable outreach for me and the ministry. God simply proved time and time again that He is the most High God! Glory be to His name forever!

Every aspect of the Asia outreach was not only guided by the hand of God but was also a miracle adventure! Getting the invitation to minister in the Philippines was just the manifestation of the fulfillment of visions the Lord had given me years before – to paint the globe with the name of Jesus. However, as this invitation was impromptu, I had to trust God for miracle provision of the funds which was just another miracle of God!

The day after the ticket and other logistics were in place for the Asia outreach, I realized The Philippines had some political unrest and it was a bit disturbing. I began to doubt whether to go but the ticket was non-refundable therefore, I committed to trusting God with my life as I went. Also, I had discouraging comments from certain people but God is always true and every man a liar (Romans 3:4).

Saints of God, it was absolutely a step of faith in God which was very profitable (Hallelujah!).

Day 1 (Wednesday, October 26 – Thursday, October 27, 2005): Trip to The Philippines

The vision of spreading the water of life to every nation was being fulfilled in the eyes of two precious saints of God who drop me off at the airport in Virginia. It was to be a series of connecting flights from Norfolk, Virginia; – Detroit, Michigan; – Tokyo, Japan; – Manila, Philippines. After some delay in the Virginia Airport, we finally leave Virginia for Detroit but arrived Detroit almost late as the plane was about to leave for Tokyo en-route Manila. It was another miracle of God that I did not miss that flight and avoided traveling complications. Finally arrived in Manila Airport after briefly stopping in Tokyo, Japan. It was my first trip to Asia and I was glad it was to preach the gospel!

Upon my arrival to Manila, I was told by the airline officials that my luggage was left in Detroit (USA) and will arrive in 24 hours (next flight). Though, discomfoting, I was more concerned about getting some rest and my personal security in this new territory (Psalm 24:1). Though mid-night, we still had to drive for about 4 hours to the province base of my host. My host (Pastor Blanco) quickly introduces me to his two sons (Pastor Joseph and Joel) that came along with him to the airport and also a church worker. Driving about 4 hours to our destination was truly a great step of faith for me because it was my debut in Asia and it was night time on the road. However, the angels of God (goodness and mercy) were with me all the way!

Day 2 (Friday, October 28, 2005) Rest day

I rested the whole day after being in the air and on the road for over 24 hours. Was still expecting my baggage to arrive safely and could not change my clothes....

Took time out to pray and thank God for hitherto He had been with me guiding me by the way.

Day 3 (Saturday, October 29, 2005) Visitation, Follow-up and Youth Meeting

Later on, we visited different church buildings, pastors and members; and saw how the Lord is keeping his people despite difficult challenges.





Day 4 (Sunday, October 30, 2005) Sunday Morning Service and Inter-Church Fellowship

By the grace of God, I mounted the pulpit to preach on Sunday morning and there was a mighty presence of the Lord all through the worship service. From Sunday school, to praise worship, to the Word and all through, the spirit of God moved. The Sunday school message was almost identical to the Sunday service message. It was both on Lazarus and the Rich man. This was coincidental in the physical as I never met with the Sunday school teacher about this prior. However, the Lord moved by choosing what He wanted his people to hear. The message was titled: **“Prepare for Eternity”**. 3 souls accepted the Lord as savior that morning and then I prayed for the sick and many came out to be prayed for. Later on, the word of knowledge came for healing in the ear and two people came forward to be prayed for. Our wonderful healer (JESUS) was there to manifest His power! Amen.

Day 5 (Monday, October 31, 2005) Crusade
